When you finish a project, you are expected to complete a narrative reflection on the project. What is a narrative? It's a connected account or story of your work on your project and it is as important to your project as the work itself. This reflection allows you to honestly evaluate your work and the process you followed to complete it.

Learning how to write a strong reflection takes time. I will have higher expectations for your reflections as you move through the year and complete projects. To help you get started I've put together a list of reflection questions for you to think about and answer in your reflections.

How would you rate your time documentation? Were you descriptive with how you used your time? Could you have been more descriptive?

Why did you choose this project?

Why was this project important to you?

How did this project affect you?

Describe the process of completing this project? How did you complete it? Who helped you along the way?

Briefly describe what went well during this project? What didn't go well?

What was hard or difficult about this project?

Is there anything that you did in this project that you hadn't done before?

Did you overcome an obstacle or hurdle that you are proud of?

What surprised you?

What went well? What was less than successful?

What would you do differently?

How will this project enhance you as an individual?

How will this project enhance others?

What additional research or project could result from your project?
