TAM schools utilize NWEA, MCA, and HOPE survey results to identify student growth areas. This information is then aggregated to all staff, so it can be utilized in each student's personalized learning plan (PLP). The purpose of the PLP is to act as a scope and sequence for each student in their academic and personal learning for the year. The plan each student creates helps to drive the specific support that they need from the TAM staff. This plan is updated every six weeks to ensure the student is making progress. A variety of RTI tiered strategies are implemented with the student, based on their specific plan. The plan may include early identification of students who are struggling, providing services for identified students such as reading groups, hiring a licensed math instructor, and developing and assessing weekly SMART goals. The ongoing NWEA, MCA, and HOPE survey results, along with additional formative assessments by licensed staff, act as indicators of student success after the implementation of the strategies were put into place in the student's PLP. TAM takes a proactive approach to identify at-risk students, who have the potential to fall behind and not graduate. The amount of credit each student earns is tracked by staff on a monthly basis. Students who fall behind the required credit amounts are identified and placed on student assistance. A team is formed to work with the students to create a plan on how to help the student catch up on credits and stay on track. This is offered to all student demographic groups. TAM offers support for students outside of the school day as well as throughout the summer if they need to catch up on credits or want to work ahead. 87% of the students completed their PLP within 30 days of enrollment at DREAM Technical Academy. Those students who didn't complete it within 30 completed the PLP at a later date. PLPs are reviewed monthly with the students and are updated after the 1st semester. 100% of students completed their PLP at CHOICE Technical Academy within 30 days of enrollment. Of this 100%, 84.9% of students successfully achieved the goals written in their PLP by the end of the year.

College entry test prep programs will be available as well. 75% of students who have been continually enrolled since their 10th grade year at TAM will meet at least one of the following: complete one year or more of post-secondary credits at an accredited college or technical school completion of an internship or work experience program as determined by a licensed work experience coordinator and resulting in work readiness completion of a vocational certification.

DREAM TA did not have a work-based learning instructor so we were unable to offer work based learning for our students. Students were able to do job shadowing for a career of their choice. Only one student from DREAM participated in PSEO through our local college. DREAM - of the 25 students who graduated, only 7 were enrolled since 10th grade and 7 of the 7 or 100% completed at least one of the requirements. 1 did occupational training, 5 completed the PCA certification training, and 1 completed safe food serving certification. CHOICE TA has a work-based coordinator, and all students attending CHOICE TA that had been enrolled since their 10th grade completed a work-based learning experience. Work-based learning experiences included paid internship opportunities through companies such as Federate. Students also were given many opportunities to go on college campus visits or tour work facilities to learn about a variety of post-graduation work or educational experiences.
